THE GENERAL CONVENTION OF THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH

July, 2006

Dear Member of the 75th General Convention:

The 75th General Convention considered 355 pieces of legislation: 169 came from our Committees, Commissions, Agencies and Boards (A resolutions); 36 resolutions from Bishops (B resolutions); 52 from Dioceses and Provinces (C resolutions); and 98 resolutions from Deputies (D resolutions). (This compares to the 74th General Convention, at which there were 158 A resolutions; 28 B resolutions; 52 C resolutions; and 98 D resolutions.)

Enclosed is the summary of these actions prepared by the General Convention Office (also available, along with the adopted budget, on the web at <http://www.episcopalchurch.org/gc2006>). The summary will give you a sense of what we accomplished. Each resolution has received one of these designations:

- *Concurred:* The resolution was adopted by both Houses and has become an Act of Convention.
- *Concurred, No Funding:* The resolution was concurred, but the requested funding was not included in the adopted budget for the triennium.
- *Adopted through the Budget:* The resolution was partially or fully funded in the adopted budget (D079) for the triennium.
- *Adopted by the House of Bishops or the House of Deputies:* The resolution did not require joint action.
- *Consent to the Election of a Bishop:* The resolution received consent from a majority of bishops exercising jurisdiction and was adopted by the House of Deputies.
- *Referred to a CCAB:* The resolution has been referred to a Committee, Commission, Agency or Board (CCAB) of General Convention to study and review before the next General Convention.
- *Discharged:* One of the Houses voted to discontinue any further consideration of the resolution by a legislative committee.
- *Rejected:* One of the Houses voted on the resolution and it did not prevail.
- *Not Completed:* The resolution was acted upon by at least one House, but it did not complete the entire legislative process before Convention adjourned. The resolution did not become an Act of Convention and is considered rejected, although D098 gave me authority to refer these resolutions to the Executive Council or to a CCAB.
- *No Action:* A legislative committee did not report the resolution to the floor of either House.

We are preparing the **Journal of the 75th General Convention** as well as the updated **Constitution and Canons**. These will be the final and official documents of the General Convention. Currently, the final language, as well as the final status of each resolution is being reviewed by the General Convention Office and the Archives of the Episcopal Church. You will find the full text of resolutions on the General Convention website at <http://gc2006.org/legislation/>

General Convention is an enormous undertaking. I am grateful to the staff of the General Convention Office, to the volunteers who served in the Secretariats and to the army of additional volunteer coordinators, supervisors and workers for providing our Church the opportunity to come together and grow in God's mission. An additional word of gratitude is due to the Archives of the Episcopal Church for its efforts to assist us in assuring the accuracy of the final documents that will record the work of the 75th General Convention.

A SUMMARY OF ACTIONS OF THE 75TH GENERAL CONVENTION

ANGLICAN COMMUNION

A015: Prayers for the Holy Land. Encourages dioceses to visit and receive visitors from the Holy Land, work and pray for justice, peace and reconciliation and urge elected officials to seek solutions to realize these goals.

A159: Commitment to Interdependence in the Anglican Communion. Reaffirms the commitment of the Episcopal Church to the fellowship of churches that constitute the Anglican Communion and the desire to live into the highest degree of communion possible; asks the Presiding Officers to work with the Anglican Communion to explore ways by which there might be inter-Anglican consultation and participation on Standing Commissions of the General Convention of the Episcopal Church.

A160: Expression of Regret. Expresses regret for straining the bonds of affection in the events surrounding the General Convention of 2003 and the consequences which followed; offers "its sincerest apology to those within Anglican Communion who are offended by our failure to accord sufficient importance to the impact of our actions on our church and other parts of the Communion," and asks forgiveness.

A165: Commitment to Windsor and Listening Processes. Commends the listening process as recommended in the Windsor Report and commits the Church to participating fully and openly in this listening process. Directs that a staff person at the Episcopal Church Center be identified to further this listening process.

A166: Anglican Covenant Development Process. Supports the process of the development of an Anglican Covenant, directs International Concerns Committee of the Executive Council to follow the development process and report to Council.

B032: Separate and Independent Status. Affirms that no resolution of General Convention is intended to affect either the historic separate and independent status of the churches of the Anglican Communion or the legal identity of the Episcopal Church.

ARCHIVES

A143: Relocation of the Archives of the Episcopal Church. Authorizes the Board of the Archives and the Archives Strategy Committee to relocate the Archives of the Episcopal Church and commence a fund raising campaign with the advice and consent of Executive Council.

A145: Endorsement of the Digital Archives. Endorses the Archives' website and the Digital Archives as an official site and electronic archive of the Episcopal Church.

BIBLE

C040: Support Biblical Literacy. Supports efforts to foster methods of biblical interpretation which do not lend support to oppressive systems.

D069: Supreme Authority of Scripture. Acknowledges authority of the triune God, exercised through Scripture.

BISHOPS

B033: On Election of Bishops. Calls upon Standing Committees and bishops with jurisdiction to exercise restraint by not consenting to the consecration of any candidate to the episcopate whose manner of life presents a challenge to the wider church and will lead to further

strains on communion.

BUDGET

D031: Budget Priorities, see Mission Strategy.

D079: Budget for the Episcopal Church 2007-2009. Adopts the budget for the 2007–2009 triennium including partial or full funding of the following resolutions: *A004:* Program, Budget and Finance Budget Appropriation, *A005:* HB Committee on Pastoral Development Budget Appropriation, *A089:* Pastoral Leadership Search Effort; *A106:* Fund Health Standing Commission, *A120:* Support ECP Centennial Endowment Fund; *A122:* Francophone Network; *A146:* Budget Appropriation for The Archives of the Episcopal Church; *A151:* Budgetary Funding Task Force; *D040:* Restore Justice and Mission Partnerships Fund; and *D078:* EYE Support.

CANONS

A023: Amend Canon I.1.2(n)(3). Amends Canon I.1.2 to mandate the Standing Commission on Constitution and Canons update the annotated version of the Constitution and Canons (commonly known as White & Dykman) and prepare other materials that will promote an understanding of the Constitution and Canons.

A024: Amend Canon I.9.1. Amends Canons to add Venezuela as a Diocese of Province IX.

A025: Amend Canon I. Amends list of Churches in Full Communion.

A026: Amend Canon III.12.1(d). Amends Title III to conform with new description of Churches in Full Communion, as amended in A025.

A031: Amend Canon IV.3.21(c). Adds the phrase for an Offense of Doctrine when the Presiding Bishop shall forward the Presentment, answer briefs and statements to the Presiding Judge of the Court for the Trial of a Bishop.

A032: Amend Canon IV.5. Amends the process of filing charges of presentment against a bishop.

A047: Amend Canon I.1.2(n)(12). Amends the Standing Commission on Communication's mandate.

A082: Amend Canons III.5-III.13. Amends the canons pertaining to the ministry of deacons, priests and bishops; completes the Title III revisions that were begun by the 73rd General Convention.

A084: Amend I.11.2(g). In the event of a vacancy in the office of Bishop assigned jurisdiction in an Area Mission, gives the Presiding Bishop authority to appoint another Bishop as substitute until the vacancy is filled by the House of Bishops.

A104: Amend Canon I.1.2: Standing Commissions. Regularizes the membership of Standing Commissions; directs the Presiding Officers to make appointments to Standing Commissions no later than 90 days following the close of General Convention; and directs the Executive Officer to notify the members no later than 120 days following the close of General Convention.

A105: Amend Canon I.1.2 Standing Commission on Youth & Christian Formation. Creates the Standing Commission on Lifelong Christian Education and Formation and funds implementation.

C047: Amend Canon: Proposed Amendments to Title I, Canon 15. Amends Canons pertaining to foreign countries.

D010: Amend Canon: I.2.2: Resignation Age of Presiding Bishop. Raises the age of the resignation of the Presiding Bishop from 70 to 72.

D045: Restore "Equally Applicable" Language to Canon III.1.2. Amends Canon III to add a new Section 3.

CHILDREN

B018: Comprehensive Children's Policy. Urges Episcopalians at every level to work to ensure that governments provide adequate funding for programs that combat social and economic conditions that place children at risk or diminish children's ability to achieve their full potential in the world, and endorses the National Council of Churches comprehensive policy statement, "The Church and Children: Vision and Goals for the 21st Century Policy."

CHURCH CALENDAR

A059: Approve Liturgical Calendar Commemorations. Approves commemorations of Florence Li Tim-Oi, Janani Luwum, Philander Chase, William Temple and Clive Staples Lewis.

A060: Refer Proposed Commemoration. Refers consideration of commemoration of The Rev. Dr. John Roberts to the Standing Commission on Liturgy and Music.

A061: Date Change for Harriet Tubman Commemoration. Directs the Standing Commission on Liturgy and Music to consider a change in date for the commemoration of Harriet Ross Tubman.

A063: Additional Calendar Commemorations and A064: Authorize Trial Use of Commemorations. Authorizes trial use of commemorations for the 2007-2009 triennium for: January 8, Harriet Bedell; February 28, Anna Julie Hayward Cooper; March 13, James Theodore Holly; March 24, Oscar Romero; April 7, Tikhon; October 10, Vida Dutton Scudder; and December 30, Frances Joseph-Gaudet.

A065: Commemoration Name Change. Authorizes name change by adding "Blandina and Her Companions" to The Martyrs of Lyons.

B008: The Dorchester Chaplains. Directs the Standing Committee on Liturgy and Music to consider commemoration of the Dorchester Chaplains for inclusion in Lesser Feasts and Fasts.

C021: Bertha and Ethelbert. Directs the Standing Commission on Liturgy and Music to consider adding Bertha and Ethelbert to the Calendar of Lesser Feasts and Fasts.

CHURCH MUSIC

A073: Praise & World Music. Directs the Standing Commission on Liturgy and Music to continue work begun on the Praise and World Music Hymnal project and provides funding for implementation.

A079: Leadership Program for Musicians Serving Small Congregations. Endorses the continuation of the Leadership Program for Musicians Serving Small Congregations and provides funding for implementation.

CHURCH PENSION FUND

A140: Women Clergy Retirement Needs. Affirms the work of the Church Pension Group (CPG) in considering ways to respond to the needs of ordained women as they approach retirement and requests that CPG consult with the Committee on the Status of Women to further this work.

B003: Church Pension Fund and Chaplains to the Retired. Expresses appreciation to the Church Pension Fund for creation of the network of Diocesan Chaplains to the Retired Clergy, Spouses and Surviving Spouses and

encourages every diocese to make provision to support and enhance this ministry.

D033: Episcopal Clergy Wellness Report. Commends CREDO for "Episcopal Clergy Wellness: A Report to The Church on the State of Clergy Wellness," affirms its recommendations, and encourages CREDO to work collaboratively with other offices to address these recommendations.

D048: Equitable Benefits for Small Church Workers. Requests that the Church Pension Fund investigate the formula for awarding credited years of service for participants receiving part time compensation.

CIVIL RIGHTS

A095: Gay and Lesbian Affirmation. Affirms support of gay and lesbian persons and opposes any state or federal constitutional amendment that prohibits same-sex civil marriages or civil unions.

CLERGY BENEFITS

A121: CPF: An Instrument of Mission. Affirms the efforts of the Church Pension Group to meet existing and future needs of clergy in overseas dioceses.

D065: Family Leave Pension Waiver. Requests a study of the feasibility of a Family Leave Pension Waiver for clergy taking time off to care for family members.

D075: Study of Retirement Benefits of Ordained Overseas Clergy. Calls for a study of retirement benefits of members of clergy originally ordained in another Anglican jurisdiction who have joined the Church Pension Fund.

COMMITTEES AND COMMISSIONS

D098: To Refer Incomplete Resolutions to Interim Bodies. Gives the Secretary of General Convention authority to refer resolutions that were not completed at the 75th General Convention to the Executive Council or an interim body.

COMMUNICATIONS

A051: Electronic CCAB Meetings. Directs CCAB's to work more economically, make use of on-line tools, conference calls and video conferencing.

CONGREGATIONS

A006: Triennial Survey of Congregations. Directs Director of Research to conduct a survey of congregations each triennium.

CONSECRATION OF BISHOPS

D027: Consent to the Election of the Rev. William Howard Love as Bishop Coadjutor of the Diocese of Albany, *D035:* Consent to the Election of the Rev. David M. Reed as Bishop Suffragan of the Diocese of West Texas, *D036:* Consent to the Election of the Rev. Steven T. Ousley as Bishop Coadjutor of the Diocese of Eastern Michigan, *D037:* Consent to the Election of the Right Rev. Marc H. Andrus as Bishop Diocesan of the Diocese of California, *D038:* Consent to the Election of the Rev. Canon Barry L. Beisner as Bishop Coadjutor of the Diocese of Northern California, and *D039:* Consent to the Election of the Venerable Dena Harrison as Bishop Suffragan of the Diocese of Texas.

CONSTITUTION

A018 Amend Article II. 2 [Election of Bishops-Second Reading]. Amends Constitution Article II.2 to state that if the election of a bishop takes place within 120 days of General Convention, the consent of the House of Deputies shall be

required in place of a majority of Standing Committees.

A019: Amend Article I.7 [Meeting of General Convention-Second Reading]. Amends Constitution Article I.7 to state that General Convention is to meet at a time and place determined in accordance with the Canons.

A020: Amend Article I.2 [House of Bishops-First Reading]. First reading of a proposed amendment to the Constitution that would give all bishops seat and voice in the House of Bishops and give vote to all bishops with jurisdiction, Bishops Coadjutor, Bishops Suffragan, Assistant Bishops and every bishop holding an office created by General Convention. [Resolution was proposed as a second reading but the text of the resolution was substituted by the House of Bishops therefore the resolution becomes a first reading.]

A021: Amend Article VIII [First Reading]. First reading of a proposed amendment to the Constitution, Article VIII that would allow a bishop to permit an ordained minister in good standing in a church in full communion as specified by the canons may officiate on a temporary basis as an ordained minister of this church.

COURTESY

B005: Commend the Order of St. John of Jerusalem, *B036:* Gratitude to the Presiding Bishop, *C052:* Charles M. Crump, *D093:* Appreciation for House of Deputies Leadership, *D094:* Appreciation for the Election of our Presiding Bishop-elect, *D096:* Appreciation for Podium, and *D097:* Thanksgiving for the President-elect & the Vice-President-elect.

DIVERSITY

A092: Applaud Anti-Racism Work. Applauds the training provided by the Anti-Racism Committee and Church Center staff.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

D022: MDGs and the ONE Episcopalian Campaign. Establishes work toward the achievement of the Millennium Development Goals as a mission priority for this triennium, urges each diocese, congregation and parishioner to commit to 0.7% giving by July 7, 2007 (07/07/07). Endorses The ONE Campaign.

ECUMENISM

A055: UMC Interim Eucharistic Sharing. Rejoices in the substantial progress of the United Methodist-Episcopal Dialogue, recognizes The United Methodist Church as a member of the one, holy, Catholic and apostolic Church, and authorizes interim Eucharistic sharing as a step toward possible full communion.

D080: Episcopal-Moravian Dialog. Commends and encourages the work of the Moravian-Episcopal Dialogue.

EDUCATION

A129: Affirm Creation and Evolution. Calls for church members to encourage legislatures and school boards to establish standards for science education based on the best available scientific knowledge as accepted by a consensus of the scientific community.

C045: Support of Historically Black Colleges. Commends leadership of the three historically black colleges—St. Augustine's, St. Paul's, and Voorhees—and requests restoration of funding to its original 2003 level.

EMPLOYEE BENEFITS

A147: Church-wide Healthcare Feasibility Study. Endorses a church-wide study of the costs and issues surrounding the

provision of healthcare benefits to all clergy and lay employees; dioceses, parishes and other church institutions are urged to cooperate.

ENVIRONMENT

B002: Response to Global Warming. Urges Episcopalians to support efforts that seek to reduce global warming, and urges Executive Council and Committee on Social Responsibility in Investments to use resources to promote a sustainable global environment and report results to Council no later than its fall 2007 meeting.

C018: Environmental Stewardship. Affirms that the response to global warming is a deeply moral and spiritual issue, recognizes that the use of fossil fuels harm air quality and public health, acknowledges the work of Interfaith Power and Light, and encourages all members to consider prayerfully whether to partner with Interfaith Power and Light.

EQUALITY

D024: Gender Equality for Women in the Episcopal Church. Endorses Resolution 13/31 adopted by the Anglican Consultative Council (ACC), which calls for equal participation of women and men on all decision-making bodies of the ACC and urges all provinces, dioceses and congregations of the Episcopal Church to work toward the same goal of equal participation.

EVANGELISM

A037: Evangelism. Reaffirms commitment to improve the health of congregations and work toward goals of 20/20. Directs Church Center staff to engage diverse populations, and directs that this resolution be published in congregational and diocesan media.

A042: Church Planting Initiative. Calls on every diocese to identify and document prime opportunities for the development of new congregations.

B011: Special Missionary Initiative. Directs the Presiding Officers, Executive Council, staff, Episcopal, Relief and Development, and the Church Pension Group in coordination with Diocese of Louisiana, to develop a strategy for a model missionary initiative. Directs Mission Office to develop a recommended structure and timeline for implementation; encourages all dioceses to participate and provides funding.

B023: Evangelism-Response to Reported Decline. Directs Office of Mission and Standing Commission on Domestic Mission and Evangelism to initiate a national consultation on methods and strategies to identify best practices to reverse the decline in mainline denominations, study this decline and make recommendations to the 76th General Convention.

FORWARD MOVEMENT

A150: Continue Forward Movement. Authorizes continuation of Forward Movement Publication under supervision of Presiding Bishop.

GENERAL CONVENTION

A001: 77th General Convention. Approves Charlotte, NC, New Orleans, LA, Indianapolis, IN and Kansas City, MO as sites to be considered for the 77th General Convention in 2012.

A154: Regarding General Convention Resolutions. Directs General Convention Office to convey all filed resolutions electronically on a weekly basis beginning 60 days before the opening day of General Convention.

D059: Child Care Facilities at General Convention. Directs that age appropriate care and education programs be available for children birth to age twelve for the duration of the 76th General Convention and all future General Conventions.

HIV/AIDS

A131: Continue HIV/AIDS Committee. Authorizes continuation of Executive Council Committee on HIV/AIDS.

A132: Eliminate HIV/AIDS Stigma. Urges church members to work to eliminate the stigma of HIV/AIDS.

A133: HIV/AIDS Media Campaign. Authorizes Communication Office to collaborate with the National Episcopal AIDS Coalition (NEAC) in producing a working group of interested parties to design, fund and implement a campaign to raise awareness about the continuing HIV pandemic.

A134: HIV Training. Directs the Office of Peace and Justice Ministries to develop an HIV training curriculum that is web-based and encourages diocese to have lay and ordained leadership complete training.

HUMAN RIGHTS

D005: Opposing Criminalization of Homosexuality. Declares efforts to criminalize homosexual behavior to be incompatible with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

IMMIGRATION

A017: Fundamental Immigration Principles. Adopts as a fundamental principle basic rights of undocumented aliens and directs the church to undertake a campaign to educate Episcopalians to the plight of refugees, immigrants and migrants.

JUSTICE

A167: "Full and Equal Claim" for All the Baptized. Affirms that gay and lesbian persons are by Baptism full members of The Episcopal Church, reiterates its apology for years of rejections and maltreatment by the Church, and pledges to include openly gay and lesbian persons on every committee, commission or task force developed for the specific purpose of discussing issues about sexuality.

C011: Church Responsibility in Reparations. Affirms commitment to become an anti-racist church and work toward healing and reconciliation. Urges the Church at every level to support legislation initiating study of and dialogue about the history and legacy of slavery.

C012: Episcopal Network for Economic Justice. Supports the Episcopal Network for Economic Justice in their facilitation of congregational training in economic justice.

LABOR

C008: Right of Workers to Organize. Reaffirms right of workers in the United States to organize and form unions, especially seasonal and migrant workers who historically have been deprived of those rights.

D047: Justice, Respect, and a Living Wage. Actively supports the rights of workers to form a union, and directs the Church to contract solely with union hotels for its meetings or ensure that "living wages" are paid by all hotels the Church uses.

LESSER FEASTS AND FASTS

A057: Lesser Feasts & Fasts Revision Principles. Approves principles of revision to be substituted for guidelines approved by the 1994 General Convention (2003 edition of Lesser Feasts and Fasts, p. 477-479).

A058: Continue Lesser Feasts & Fasts Revision. Affirms work of revision on Lesser Feasts and Fasts and provides funding for implementation.

D006: Expanded Use of Daily Office Lectionary. Directs Standing Commission on Liturgy and Music to consider revising the instructions to Lesser Feasts and Fasts, and to report its findings to the 76th General Convention.

LITURGY

A062: Approve a Common for Space Exploration. Authorizes inclusion of a common for Space Exploration in Lesser Feasts and Fasts.

A066: Multi-sensory Resources. Directs the Standing Commission on Liturgy and Music to engage younger generations in the collection and development of liturgical resources.

A067: Rites of Passage Publication. Approves for experimental use the Rites and Liturgical materials found in "Rites of Passage".

A069: Enriching our Worship Eucharistic Prayers. Directs the Standing Commission on Liturgy and Music to continue development of liturgical materials for inclusion in the "Enriching Our Worship" series and provides funding for implementation.

A070: Enriching our Worship Adoption of Children. Directs the Standing Committee on Liturgy and Music to develop liturgical materials in the "Enriching Our Worship" series to include pastoral issues in the context of the adoption of children.

A071: Burial & Reconciliation Liturgical Materials. Directs the Standing Committee on Liturgy and Music to develop liturgical materials in the "Enriching Our Worship" series to create additional resources in the areas of Burial of the Dead and Reconciliation of a Penitent.

A072: Multi-Cultural Musical Resources. Directs the Standing Commission on Liturgy and Music to gather a collection of music to broaden the cultural breadth of the music of the church, and appoint a committee to oversee the collection of this music.

A074: Authorize Enriching Our Worship 3. Authorizes continuing use of "Enriching our Worship Volume 1: The Daily Office, Great Litany and Eucharist" and "Enriching our Worship Volume 2: Ministry with the Sick and Dying, and Burial of a Child" during the next triennium, under the direction of the diocesan bishop or ecclesiastical authority.

A075: A Rite for "The Renewal of Ministry". Authorizes the rite for "The Renewal of Ministry with the Welcome of a new Rector."

A076: Alternatives to the Prayer Book Burial Rites. Authorizes use of "Proposed Burial Rites for Adults" for the next triennium, under the direction of the diocesan bishop or ecclesiastical authority.

A077: Revised Common Lectionary. Directs that the Revised Common Lectionary be the Lectionary of this Church, amending the Lectionary effective the First Sunday of Advent, 2007 with the provision for continued use of the previous Lectionary for purposes of orderly transition, until the First Sunday of Advent, 2010.

A078: Liturgical Development and Episcopal Authority. Invites bishops and the larger church into dialogue about relations between local liturgical initiatives and ordered authority; directs the Standing Commission on Liturgy and Music to develop frameworks for resolving issues involved in the creation of new rites.

A088: Daily Life Liturgies. Directs the Standing Commission

on Liturgy and Music to develop liturgies which recognize and celebrate ministry in daily life.

A136: Enriching Our Worship Support. Encourages use of liturgical resources in the "Enriching Our Worship" series as appropriate for Sunday worship.

C001: Anti-Jewish Prejudice in Liturgical Texts. Directs the Standing Committee on Liturgy and Music to address anti-Jewish prejudice with suggestions for preaching.

D084: Upholding Communion of the Baptized. Directs the Theology Committee of the House of Bishops, in consultation with the Standing Commission on Liturgy and Music, to provide a pastoral and theological understanding of the relationship between Holy Baptism and Eucharistic practice.

MINISTRY

A041: University Ministry. Affirms the value of campus ministries, encourages canonical status as mission congregations where appropriate, and urges dioceses to plant new campus ministries.

A083: Clergy Resignation Age. Requests a study of the optimum mandatory retirement age for clergy, and report to 76th General Convention.

MISSION STRATEGY

A038: Diocesan Development Initiative. Directs the Director of Mission to develop new leadership programs and endorse existing leadership training programs. These programs should include a mechanism for dioceses to share their best practices and lessons learned.

D031: Budget Priorities. Sets the Budget priorities for the 2007-2009 triennium: 1) Justice and Peace (supporting 8 Millennium Development Goals), 2) Young Adults, Youth and Children, 3) Reconciliation and Evangelism, 4) Congregational Transformation, and 5) Partnerships.

D043: Dialogue on Mission of the Church. Asks for a participatory, vision focused dialogue on the Mission of the Church to take place during times dedicated to that purpose at the 76th General Convention, and asks the Executive Council to develop and implement a process for implementation.

MISSIONARY DIOCESES

A087: Committee on Missionary Dioceses. Directs the Standing Commission on Domestic Mission and Evangelism to explore the possibility of a new definition for "Missionary Dioceses".

ORDAINED MINISTRY

A034: Canonical Residence Study. Directs the Standing Commission on Constitution and Canons to study the term "Canonical Residence" and make recommendations to the 76th General Convention.

ORDINATION PROCESS

C036: Review General Ordination Examinations (GOE's). Directs the Standing Commission on Ministry Development to convene a task force to review the purpose and process of the General Ordination Examinations (GOE's).

PASTORAL CARE

A086: Committee for Pastoral Materials. Instructs the Standing Commission on Ministry Development to create and disseminate training materials to assist leaders to recognize and respond to evidence of abuse.

A163: Pastoral Care and Delegated Episcopal Pastoral Oversight.

Affirms centrality of effective and appropriate pastoral care for all members of the church and all who come seeking the aid of the church, commits to the ongoing engagement of and sensitive response to the request and need of all people of God, recognizes the agonizing position of those who do not feel able to receive appropriate pastoral care from their own bishops, and urges continued maintenance of historic diocesan boundaries, the authority of the diocesan bishop, and respect for the historical relationships of the separate and autonomous Provinces of the Anglican Communion.

D019: Pastoral Concern for Troops in Iraq and Afghanistan and their Families. Offers concern, prayer, and support for all serving in the military, particularly Iraq and Afghanistan.

PEACE

D018: Active Nonviolence Training. Urges non-violence training for personal and social change, and encourages each diocese to make available active non-violence training and to identify persons to become non-violence training facilitators.

POVERTY

A010: Affirm "Call to Partnership". Affirms "Call to Partnership" document, and calls upon governments to work towards accomplishing the millennium development goals.

PRISON MINISTRY

A111: Criminal Justice to National Concerns. Directs the Standing Commission on National Concerns to investigate issues relating to criminal justice in the United States and the ministry within the criminal justice system.

D012: Summer Camp for Children of Persons in Prison. Allows the establishment of summer camps for children of persons in prison and creation of an advisory committee to provide advice and assistance in this effort.

RECONCILIATION

A039: Reconciliation Training. Directs the Office for Ministry Development to identify and evaluate curricular materials for reconciliation training and promote the use of these materials.

A101: Stewardship of Relationships. Invites members to participate in acts of reconciliation.

A123: Slavery and Racial Reconciliation. Requests that the Presiding Bishop to name a Day of Repentance and, on that day, hold a Service of Repentance at the National Cathedral, and ask each Diocese to hold a similar service.

A127: Restorative Justice. Endorses principles of restorative justice, calls upon the Anti-Racism Committee to design a study and dialogue process to engage people in storytelling about historical and present-day privilege and under-privilege.

D046: Jamestown Covenant. Reaffirms the Jamestown Covenant and directs the Episcopal Council on Indigenous Ministries and the Office of Native American Ministries to coordinate events for the Second Decade of Remembrance, Recognition, and Reconciliation.

RULES OF ORDER

A003: Amend Joint Rules 11. Amends the Joint Rules of Order on the reporting of the audit committee to Executive Council and the Joint Standing Committee on Program, Budget and Finance.

A036: Amend HBRO XVIII. Directs that no resolution proposing amendments to Constitution or Canons be

presented in the House of Bishops for an initial vote on the last legislative day of General Convention.

B017: Amend HB Rules of Order: Courtesy Seat and Voice. Amends the House of Bishops Rules of Order to allow for a method for granting courtesy seat and voice to guest Bishops.

D015: Amend Joint Rules of Order IV.15. Amends the Joint Rules to state that any resolution with funding implications that comes up after the budget is passed will be unfunded.

SEXUAL MISCONDUCT

A156: Sexual Exploitation. Affirms work being done in many dioceses regarding sexual misconduct and directs that each diocese shall report to the House of Bishops Committee on Pastoral Development prior to the Spring 2009 meeting with a copy of its adopted and implemented policy and an evaluation of the history of its use.

SMALL CHURCHES

A098: Small Church Growth and Strategy Handbook. Directs the Office of Congregational Development to compile resources promoting mission and ministry in small congregations and develop ways of collecting and telling stories of same.

D057: Priorities for Standing Commission on Small Congregations. Directs the Standing Commission on Small Congregations to work with Church Center staff to develop and offer opportunities for leadership training in Small Church Ministry.

STRUCTURE

A108: Executive Council Committees Redesignation. Designates the Economic Justice Loan Committee as a committee of Executive Council and affirms the Episcopal Council on Indigenous Ministries and Committee on Science, Technology and Faith as committees of Executive Council.

A109: SRI Committee Mandate. Designates the Social Responsibility in Investments as a committee of Executive Council and provides mandate.

A110: Review Council Committees. Mandates a review of all committees of Executive Council to determine which shall be continued and which shall be terminated. This should be done each triennium, with recommendations reported to the Standing Commission on Structure one year before each regular meeting of General Convention.

A112: Directions for the Future. Directs commissions and committees to reevaluate mandates and placement, directs the Standing Committee on Structure to make recommendations to the 76th General Convention regarding the Church's official name with particular consideration of being inclusive of overseas dioceses and parishes, and regarding changes to the process of the nomination and election of the Presiding Bishop.

TECHNOLOGY

A048: Information Technology Working Group. Directs the Church Center and others to adopt "best practices" when adopting new technology, directs a volunteer task force to be named to implement this guideline.

A049: Adopt Open Standards for Data. Urges that the Church move toward adopting recognized open standards for data used in its electronic communications and data storage.

D082: Launch an Information Technology Cooperative. Directs the Standing Commission on Communication to organize an information technology cooperative network for dioceses and congregations.

THEOLOGICAL EDUCATION

A090: Commend PEALL. Commends the work of PEALL (Proclaiming Education for All) and affirms the continuation of this work.

B006: The Educational Debt of Seminarians. Directs the Standing Commission on Ministry Development to design strategies for raising awareness and responding to the crisis of educational debt for those preparing for ordained ministry in the Church.

D008: Reaffirm Theological Education Sunday. Requests that the Presiding Bishop continue to designate the first Sunday in February as Theological Education Sunday.

WARFARE

D020: End the War in Iraq. Calls upon Congress and the President to develop a plan for stabilization of Iraq, followed by prompt withdrawal of U.S. Armed Forces in Iraq. Requests the Standing Commission on Liturgy and Music to commission prayers and liturgies to be used in times of war.

WOMEN

A139: Celebration of Women's Ministries. Offers thanksgiving for the gift of all women in ministry and directs that dioceses that have not yet ordained women continue to be encouraged to do so.

YOUTH

A114: Young Adult Service Corps. Directs the Office of Anglican and Global Relations to increase the number of placements available in the Young Adult Service Corps from ten to fifteen.
