How to Use These Files

We hope you find these supporting documents and images helpful in telling your friends and neighbors more about your Good News Garden; proclamation is essential to this movement! Below, find more information on how these can be used most effectively.

Postcard

These postcards are best printed by a professional printing service on heavyweight paper. They include trimlines, which help the printer to know exactly where the image should be cut. The final dimensions should be roughly 4.25" x 5.5". You can use these as an invitation to a garden blessing or work day – or just to share that you're committed to sharing the Good News through your garden.



Yard Sign

Like the postcards, these should be taken to a local professional printing service. They are designed with a 3:4 aspect ratio, so will appear best on a yard sign with dimensions of 18" x 24". There are also trimlines on these files, which the printer will know to cut along rather than include in the final product. Post this at your garden to help passersby know the important ministry of which your garden is part!



Facebook Covers

This suite of three images can be upload to your Facebook profile or page to help people make the connection between your garden and this movement. Make sure to regularly post images throughout the growing season as well, along with information about where you'll donate your harvest. The three include the following messages: "Join the Good News Garden Movement"; "My Garden is a Good News Garden"; and "Our Garden is a Good News Garden".



Instagram Images

Like the Facebook covers, these can be uploaded to help proclaim the ministry you've undertaken. They are sized for a standard Instagram post. Again, make sure to regularly post images throughout the growing season, along with information about where you'll donate your harvest. The three include the following messages: "Join the Good News Garden Movement"; "My Garden is a Good News Garden"; and "Our Garden is a Good News Garden".
